Diweddariad Cyngor Cymuned – Llais Cemaes - Chwefror 2019

Mae tri aelod newydd wedi eu croesawu i'r Cyngor yn cynrychioli Ward Cemaes – Peter Cross, Vic Ensor a Kevin Barnett.

Mae'r Cyngor Cymuned wedi parhau i gwrdd yn reolaidd, ar gyfer cyfarfodydd cyffredin y cyngor a cyfarfodydd penodol gyda Horizon ynglyn a'r cais 'Development Consent Order' a datblygu Datganiad Tir Cyffredin. Mae'r Cyngor wedi eu siomi gyda datganiad Hitachi i roi stop ar y prosiect mor hwyr yn y broses datblygu. Hoffai'r Cyngor ddiolch i'r holl staff sydd wedi bod yn cydweithio a thrafod gyda'r Cyngor drwy gydol y broses o ddatblygu'r prosiect.

Mae Aelodau yn parhau o roi pwysau at y Cyngor Sir mewn perthynas a gwaharddiadau cyflymder a chroesfannau drwy'r pentref ac yn enwedig yn Nhregele; mae'r Cyngor wedi cwrdd a'r Aelodau Sirol ar gyfer yr ardal mewn partneriaeth a Chyngor Cymuned Mechell sydd hefyd yn bryderus am gerbydau yn gor-yrru yn Nhregele a'r sgwar.

Mae gwaith yn parhau gyda Dwr Cymru, Cyfoeth Naturiol Cymru 'r Cyngor Sir ynglyn a safonau glendid dwr y traeth. Roedd canlyniadau tymor trochi 2018 yn bositif iawn gyda canlyniadau'r samplau dwr yn foddhaol. Mae'r asiantaethau wedi gaddo eu cefnogaeth parhaus am y tymor nesaf gan gynnwys cyflogi warden ar y traeth yn llawn amser drwy gydol y tymor trochi.

Mae'r Cyngor Cymuned yn ymgynghorwr statudol ar gyfer pob cais cynllunio yn yr ardal, ac mae'r aelodau wedi cael y cyfle i ystried pob cais sydd wedi eu cyflwyno gan y Cyngor Sir. Mae'r penderfyniad terfynnol fodd bynnag gyda swyddogion yr adain gynllunio yn Llangefni beth bynnag fydd sylwadau'r Cyngor Cymuned.

Mae'r aelodau wedi cael gwybod am gynlluniau cychwynnol y Cyngor Sir ar gyfer moderneiddio ysgolion dalgylch gogledd dwyrain Mon. Nid oedd yr aelodau yn gallu ymateb i'r ymgysylltiad yn llawn nes bydd gwybodaeth llawn yndod i law gan y Cyngor Sir. Mae disgwyl ymgynghoriad ffurfiol yn fuan yn y flwyddyn ariannol newydd,

Wrth edrych i'r flwyddyn ariannol newydd, mae'r aelodau wedi trafod a chytuno ar gyllideb y cyngor cymuned wrth ystyried y gofynnion a cyfrifoldebau ar hyn o bryd. Cytuo byddai'r priseb yn codi 3.75%.

Community Council Update – Cemaes Voice – Feb 2019

Three new members have been welcomed onto the Council representing the Cemaes Ward – Peter Cross, Vic Ensor and Kevin Barnett.

The Community Council has continued to meet on a regular basis, both for ordinary council meetings and specific meeting with Horizon in relation to the Development Consent Order Application and developing a Statement of Common Ground. The Council were very disappointed to hear the statement from Hitachi putting the Wylfa Newydd project on hold so late in the day, and wish to thank all the staff who have been liaising with the council through the many stages of project development.

Members are continuing to put pressure on the County Council with regard to speed restrictions and crossings throughout the village and especially in Tregale; the Council have met with the County Councillors for the area in partnership with Mechell Community Council who are also concerned with speeding vehicles through Tregale and the square.

Work with Welsh Water, National Resources Wales and the County Council is ongoing with regard to addressing the water quality at the beach. Results for the 2018 bathing season were positive with the water quality samples being rated as satisfactory. The agencies have pledged their ongoing support for the 2019 season including the presence of a full time beach warden onsite throughout the bathing season.

The community council is a statutory consultee for planning applications in the community and members have the opportunity to carefully consider each application presented by the County Council. The ultimate decision as to whether permission is granted or not lies with the planning officers at Llangefni regardless of the Community Council's observations.

The members have also been made aware of the County Council's initial proposals for schools modernisation in the North East Anglesey catchment area. The members were unable to respond fully to the engagement exercise until full information is made available by the County Council. The formal consultation is expected early in the new financial year.

Looking in to the new financial year, the members have discussed and approved a budget for the community council taking into account the demands and responsibilities at present. It was agreed that the precept should be increased by 3.75%.
