## **Cofnodion o gyfarfod y Cyngor Llawn a gynhaliwyd nos Fawrth 17/9/2019** **Minutes of the Full Council meeting held on Tuesday evening 17/9/2019**

### **1 Croeso / Welcome**

*The meeting was chaired by Derek Owen, he welcomed all to the meeting. It was noted that both Carys Davies and Peter Cross had given their apologies on grounds of ill health. Agreed to accept their apologies for the period of illness and recovery.*

### **2 Datgan Diddordeb / Declaration of Interest**

### **3 Wylfa Newydd (Ifer Gwyn)**

*Ifer Gwyn was thanked for attending the meeting. A general update was given regarding the Wylfa Newydd site and the project in general. The decision on the DCO is due 23/10/2019 and this will determine the next step if the project.*

### **4 Dylan Williams (Datblygu Economaidd / Economic Development)**

*Dylan Williams was welcomed to the meeting. Mr Williams gave an overview of IACC's vision for North Anglesey having secured £495k from the NDA over a three-year period. He explained that a programme of schemes and a framework was to be developed to be able to release the funding. It was explained that the funding was not for community projects but rather the wider economic benefit of the region.*

*Possible proposals include –*

- Retaining talented young people through an apprenticeship scheme, with work placements being offered on the NDA/Magnox sites.*
- Developing a business case for North Anglesey to be designated an enterprise zone, enabling the draw down of further funding. Potential sites have been identified such as the Rehau site in Amlwch.*
- Development of Amlwch Port as a tourist destination and review the tourism plan. There is further funding available up to £100K via a new WG tourism grant that could add value to the NDA funding already secured.*

*It was agreed that it was important to keep young people and their families in the area, and that employment opportunities would enable people to stay.*

*Members were concerned that the NDA funding would be a paper exercise and that all funds would be spent on administrative work with no real impact being made in the communities.*

*Derek Owen noted that the development of a touring caravan park in the Cemaes area would bring more people to the area. Since the closure of Park Lodge, there is no such facility in the immediate area. Agreed that IACC would look whether the current policy would allow for the reinstatement of capacity.*

*An industrial heritage trail bringing together Mynydd Parys, Amlwch Port, Porthwen etc was discussed as a possible project. The Coastal Path was acknowledged as being one of the best investments of late and being very well used and a great attraction for visitors and locals*

alike. All present agreed that a heritage trail joining the different communities would be beneficial and relatively low cost.

Dylan Williams noted that he intended to discuss possible ideas with both the Twrcelyn Alliance and the North Anglesey Councils' Partnership so that the NDA funding was prioritised accordingly. Dylan Williams was thanked for attending the meeting.

Derek Owen gave an overview of the finance committee meeting. He noted that the refurbishment of the flat was now complete and the property to be marketed by Dafydd Hardy Estate Agents. The Village Venture Shop have asked for a new door at a cost of £1.6k, this for both security and energy efficiency. It was noted that WE Jones would be awarded the contract for cemetery path, with the work to be complete as soon as possible. The committee have agreed to contribute towards the cost of the annual bonfire night. A list of payments and the monthly finance report is available to members should they wish to discuss further.
