1. Croeso ac Ymddiheiriadau / Welcom and Apologies

Bu i Carys Davies gadeirio'r cyfarfod ac estyn croeso i bawb. Nid oedd y cyfieithydd yn bresennol / Carys Davies chaired the meeting and welcomed everyone. The translator was not present.

3. Cofnodion y cyfarfod diwethag / Minutes of the last meeting

Derbyniwyd y cofnodion yn gywir cynnig Brian Potter ac eilio Enid Jones / *The minutes were approved, proposed Brian Potter seconded by Enid Jones.*

5. Diweddariadau / Updates

5.1 Aeth Enid Jones drwy agenda y cyfarfod cyllid a chrynhai'r cyfarfod / *Enid Jones went through the finance meeting agenda and gave a summary of the meeting*

5.2 Dymunodd Derek Owen yn dda i Elfed Jones o flaen ei driniaeth yn yr Ysbyty yfory. Adroddodd Elfed Jones ei fod wedi ymweld a cae chwarae Treglele a nodwyd fod rhai o'r offerynau angen ei llau a'r glastwell angen ei dorri, mae'r ffens o amgylch y parc angen ei drwshio mewn manau. Elfed Jones am ddilyn i fynny. Derek Owen am gysylltu a Rhys torri gwair a Nia Jones am gysylltu a'r adran Priffyrdd. Elfed Jones mewn cysylltiad a 2 berson sydd wedi holi am meinciau cof.

Talwyd £60 i James am lanhau yr iddew a moss oddiar wal y toiledau fe wnaeth hefyd roi pris of £20 i lanhau y grisiau wrth yr Harbour. Mae pris o £300 wedi ei gael am glirio rwbel ayyb yn Maes Cynfor roedd hwn i weld braidd yn ddrud felly Carys Davies i gael pris arall. Holodd Elfed Jones am gael banner ar y pier i ddathlu D-day. Un syniad hefyd oedd gofyn i'r ysgol of fuasai'r plant yn cerdded lawr i'r cof golofn ar y diwrnod. Awgrymodd Aled Morris Jones bod y plant yn cerdded fynny o'r traeth efo lamp wedi ei goleuo at y cof colomn ac y gallai hyn gyd-daro efo clychaf'r eglwys yn canu am 6.30. Carys Davies am gael gair efo'r ysgol. Mae meinciau ym mhen draw y traeth angen ei llau, Lowri Jones yn gwybod am rywyn fasa yn gallu gwneud hyn

felly am gael gair efo nhw. Mae arwyddion "Dim BBQ's " ac arwydd newydd pris parcio y maes lawr y traeth wedi cael eu archebu. Awgrymodd trigolion Cemaes cael plat metal ar y meinciau er mwyn rhoi BBQ arno ond y teimlad oedd buasai'r plat yn poethi ac aros yn boeth am beth amser wedyn a gallai rhywyn gyffwrdd ynddo heb wybod ei fod yn boeth. Clerc I yrru ebost I'r aelodau yn gofyn am eu sylwadau ynglyn a hyn. Dywedodd Dafydd Williams bydd rhaid I'r fflagiau presennol gael eu tynnu lawr er mwyn adnewyddu y polion. Awgrymodd Elfed Jones cael un banner ar y pier ac un yn y stryd. Mae'r clerch am edrych am fflagiau a beth sydd ar gael.

Derek Owen expressed good wishes to Elfed Jones on his hospital treatment tomorrow. Elfed Jones reported he had visited the playing field in Tregale and noted that the equipment could do with cleaning, also the grass needs cutting and the fence around the playing field needs repairing in places. Elfed Jones to follow up and Derek Owen will consult with Rhys re grass cutting and Nia will consult with Highways. Elfed Jones in contact with 2 people who would like memorial benches. £60 paid to James for taking down Ivy and moss on toilet walls he also quoted a price £20 for cleaning steps by Harbour Hotel. A price of £300 has been given to clear rubble etc from Maes Cynfor this was thought to be a bit steep therefore Carys Davies will get another price also. Elfed Jones enquired about a flag on the pier to commemorate D-day. Derek Owen suggested that the school children could walk down to the war memorial. Aled Morris Jones suggested the children could walk up from the beach to the war memorial carrying a lamp which would be lit. This could coincide with the church bells ringing at 6.30. Carys Davies will speak to the school. The far end beach benches need cleaning Lowri Jones knows of someone who might do them and will consult with them. New "No BBQ" signs and Car Parking sign have been ordered. A suggestion was made by Cemaes residents to have a metal plate on the benches to place the BBQ's on the general feeling was that the plates would become hot and retain their heat for some time afterwards. Someone could touch the plates not realizing that the plate was still hot. Clerk to send an email to members asking for their comments on this. Dafydd Williams said that existing flags would have to be taken down beforehand in order to repair the flag poles. Elfed Jones suggested one flag on the pier and one in on the high street. Clerk will look for flags on line.

5.3 Pwyllgor yr Harbwr/ Harbour Committee

Mae Hari White yn edrych ar y peiriant CCTV. Disgwyl am dywydd gwell er mwyn glanhau y cheini ac edrych ar gyflwr y polion fflagiau. Ar wahan I hyn dim mwy I adrodd.

Hari White will look at the CCTV equipment . Waiting for better weather to clean the chains and the condition of the flag poles.

5.4 Fe fuodd Derek Owen mewn cyfarfod GBN. Dim byd I adrodd popeth mewn

limbo ar y funud. Bu Enid Jones mewn cyfarfod Unllais Cymru. Adroddodd yn ol l’r aelodau y materion a drafodwyd fel yr Ambulans Awyr yn costio £11.2m y flwyddyn l’w redeg. Cafwyd fyr syniad o sut mae’r ambulans awyr yn cael ei gynnal Danghoswyd templedi yn ymwenuad ag apwyntio cler, mathau o insiwrans ayyb. Dywedodd Enid Jones fe drafodwyd ffi y Cynghorwyr yn y cyfarfod ac os nad ydynt yn ei dderbyn dylent wneud y cler yn ymwybodol o hyn drwy ebost. Roedd un Cyngorydd yn y cyfarfod yn bryderus o’r cynlluniau l godi nifer o dai yn ardal Gwalchmai a dywedodd fasa unrhyw gymorth yn erbyn y cais gan Cynghorau Cymunedol Ynys Mon yn werthfawr iawn.

Derek Owen attended a meeting with GBN. Nothing to report everything in limbo at the moment. Enid Jones attended a meeting with Unllais Wales. She reported a number of topics discussed like the Wales Air Ambulance and the yearly running cost being £11.2m and a briefing was given of how it works. They were shown templates of appointing a clerk, types of insurances etc. Also if the Councillors decide not to accept the fee available to them they should notify the clerk by email. A Councillor at the meeting expressed concerns regarding planning for new houses to be built in the Gwalchmai area and any support against these plant from Community Councils on Anglesey would be much appreciated.

5.5 Toiledau Cyhoeddus / Public Toilets

Carys Davies wedi derbyn ebost gan Huw CSYM. Nid oes cyllid ar gael yn y flwyddyn ariannol yma ond roedd o’r farn bod toiledau Cemaes mewn stad gwael a chymharu a thoiledau eraill ar yr ynys. Mae Huw am edrych l fewn os oes na unrhyw grant ar gael.

Carys Davies received an email from Huw ACC. There is no funding in place this financial year but he realizes that the toilets need attention and are in a bad state compared to other public toilets on the island. He will look into what grants might be available.

7. Gohebaeth / Correspondence

Darlennodd Carys Davies ebost gan Anthony Barry re: Nant y Scrwngi yn nodi ei bryderon bod y Nant yn colli ei gyflwr naturiol. Roedd yn pryderu bod coed y ddreunan ddu a’r ddreunen wen wedi cael ei torri lawr. Dywedodd Dei Owen ei fod yntau yn siomedig am hyn ac y dylai’r gwrychynod yma gael eu hail blannu a dywedodd Dei Owen ei fod yn fodlon gwneud hyn. Dywedodd Pauline Roberts bod Scottish Power sydd wedi torri llawer o goed mawr l lawr.

Derbynodd y Cyngor ebost gan Gwyn Williams re: Ty Cefn, Cemaes. a cafodd ei ddarllen allan yn y cyfarfod. Mae Ty Cefn ar werth drwy ocsiwn ond teimlad Gwyn Williams ac eraill ydi dylai yr adeilad yma gael ei gadw yn nwylo trigolion Cemaes.

Mae yn adeilad Graddfa 1 ac yn unigryw l'r ardal. Yr awgrym oedd I greu grwp o bobol sydd yn angerddol am gadw'r adeilad a'l brynnu a chael Cronfa Padrig dan sylw er mwyn drïo sicrhau cael tynnu yr adeilad oddiar y farchnad. Dywedodd Derek Owen fuasai'r Cyngor Cymuned yn gefnogol I bobl y pentre brynnu'r adeilad, ond fuasa raid l'r penderfyniad o brynnu fod yn nwylo Cronfa Padrig. Nodwyd I Gwyn Williams bod Cronfa Padrig yn cyfarfod ar y 14/5 ac fasai'n syniad cael unrhyw waith papur iddyn nhw erbyn 6/5 er mwyn iddynt cael ei drafod yn y cyfarfod. Awgrymodd Aled Morris Jones buasai Magnox yn gefnogol l'r cais a hefyd Ymddiriedolaeth Elusennol Ynys Mon.

Darlennwyd ebost a dderbyniwyd gan Jacque Evans ac aeth Carys Davies dryw'r pwyntiau a godwyd yn yr ebost:

Mae'r lon o'r Gadlys at y traeth nawr wedi ei thrin. Adroddodd Enid Jones bod cwynion o lifogydd ar y lon lawr o Nant y Fran l'r cyffordd Derek Owen am siarad ag Alun Priffyrdd. Holodd Jacqui Evans am cyfrifon 22/23 eto ac unwaith eto dywedwyd wrthi eu bod yn dal I fod yng Nghaerdydd. Does dim dyddiad eto I wneud gwaith y llwybrau. Cwynion am traenia wedi cau wrth 58-59 Stryd Fawr. Gobeithio cynnal cyfarfod agored y mis dibynnumhen ryw fis dibynnu ar pwy fedrith fynegu ,diwrnod ag amser l'w gadarnhau. Dywedodd Pauline Roberts bod y peiriant llnau lonnydd yn fodlon newid ei "route" yn y pentref. Jacque Evans yn ofni bod y chwyn laddwr sydd yn cael ei ddefnyddo yn beryg. Cafodd ei awgrymu gan y trigolion eu bod nhw yn rhoi y chwyn laddwr I lawr ond mae rhaid cael trwydded arbennig I weithio efo chwyn laddwr mewn mannau cyhoeddus felly nid yw hyn yn bosib.

Awgrymodd Dei Owen bod y Cyngor Cymuned yn rhoi mewn ebost nad yw neb I wneud unrhyw waith yn Nant y Scrwngi oherwydd bydd Dwr Cymru yn gwneud archwiliad o ollyngiad yn y safle. Dywedodd Jacqui Evans y bydd y "Feature Entance" I gyd I fynny mhen 2 wythnos a gobeithio am agoriad swyddogol diwedd mis Mai y dyddiad I gael ei gadarnhau. Mae Robin Grove White yn awyddus I wneud yr agoriad. Mae grant gan Medrwn Mon l'r cae chwarae wedi cael ei wrthod. Mae John Beardsley wedi rhoi pris o dan £5000 I weud y Gwaith llwybrau. Mae'r "toddler area" yn y parc yn wlyb a mwldud dywedodd Jacque Evans y buasai gwneud llwybyr o'r Hwb ar draws l'r ardal hyn yn costio tua £3000. Jacqui Evans am ebostio Carys Davies efo'r costau.

Biniau – ACC yn ymweld yfory.17/4

Bydd pob gohebaeth eraill drwy ebost yn cael eu gyrru mlaen gan y clerc l'r aelodau.

Email from Anthony Barry re: Nant y Scrwngi was read out by Carys Davies. That the natural habitat of the Nant wasn't being reserved with the Blackthorn and Hawthorn having been cut down. Dei Owen also expressed concern about this and feels that the Hawthorn and Blackthorn should be replanted and is willing to do this himself. Pauline Roberts said that some of the large trees have also been cut by Scottish Power.

An email from Gwyn Williams was also read out regarding Ty Cefn, Cemaes. Ty Cefn is currently for sale by auction but Gwyn Williams feels that a building

of it's kind, which is Grade 1 Listed and unique to the area, should be owned by the people of Cemaes. It was suggested that a group of people who are keen for this to happen should get together and form a committee in order to try and ensure the property be taken off the market. Derek Owen said that the Community Council would be supportive of the purchase and suggested a meeting with Cronfa Padrig could be useful as the decision to purchase Ty Cefn would have to be with them. Gwyn Williams was advised that Cronfa Padrig meet on the 14/5 and it would be useful for him to get a group together before the meeting along with any paperwork and hand it in around the 6/5 so that it may be discussed in their meeting. Aled Morris Jones suggested Magnox would be supportive and also Anglesey Charitable Trust.

Email received by Jacqui Evans was read out by Carys Davies.

Road from Gadlys to the beach has been patched. Enid Jones reported complaints regarding flooding at the bottom of the road from Nant y Fran to the junction. Derek Owen will chase Alun ACC. Jacqui Evans asked about the 22/23 account and was again told that they were still in Cardiff with Audit Wales. No date yet for the path works. Reports of blocked drains near 58-59 High Street. Hoping to get an open meeting arranged in the coming month depending who's available to attend date and time to be arranged. Pauline Roberts said that the sweeper was prepared to change it's route. Jacqui Evans commented on the weed killer used might be harmful it was suggested by the residents that they could apply the weed killer themselves however a person applying weed killer in public area must hold the required licence to do so. The fallen tree in Nant y Scrwngi has been cleared away and area made safe. The work was carried out next day. Dei Owen asked if an email could be sent to those it may concern that no works be carried out at Nant y Scrwngi while Welsh Water are undertaking investigative work for leaks. The feature entrances should be completed in 2 weeks. Hoping for official opening end of May date to be confirmed. Robin Grove White is keen to do the opening. Applied to Menter Mon for playing field grant but unsuccessful. John Beardsley given a price of under £5000 for the pathworks. The toddler area is very wet and muddy a path from the Hub across to the toddler area would cost around £3000. Jacqui Evans to email Carys Davies with costs.
